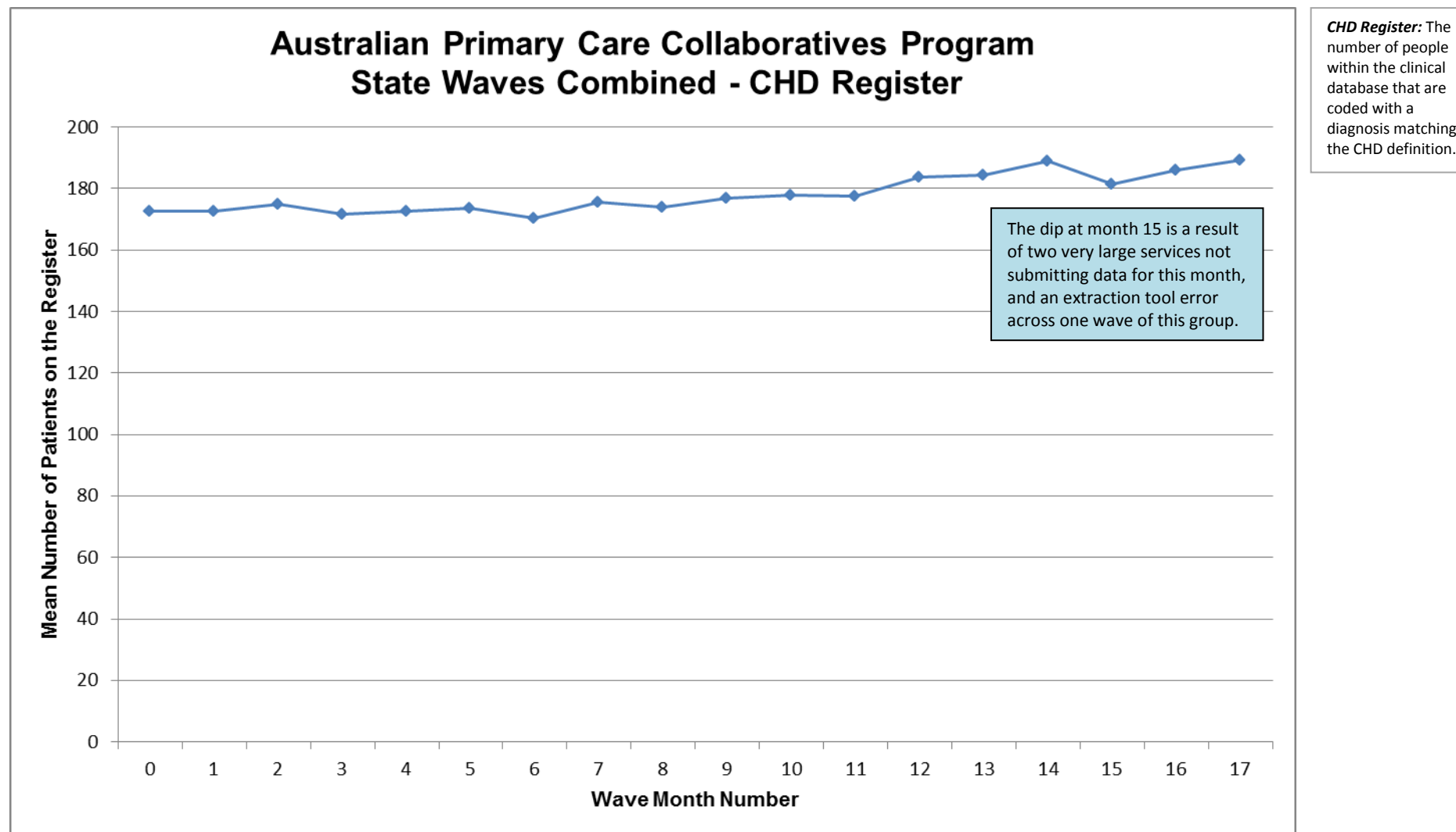


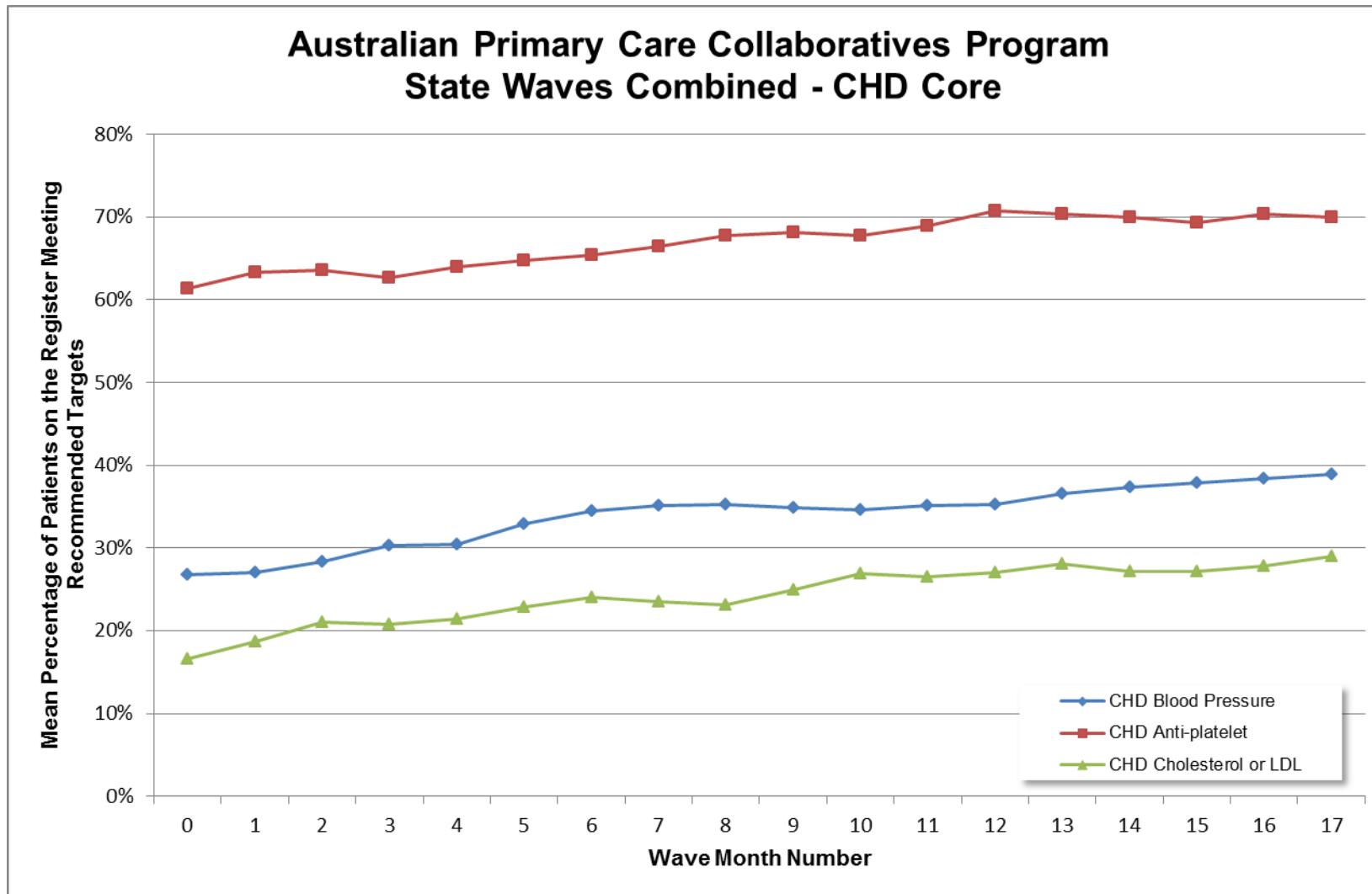
Aggregated Coronary Heart Disease (CHD) Results (May 2008 – Feb 2011)

280 Health Services



The CHD Register shows a steady increase overall, as participants in the combined waves have continued to identify and improve the recording of patients with Coronary Heart Disease in their health service databases.

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CHD Blood Pressure:
 The % of people on the CHD register who have a blood pressure record in the last 12 months of $\leq 130/80$.

CHD Anti-platelet:
 The % of people on the CHD register who are currently prescribed an anti-platelet agent.

CHD Cholesterol or LDL:
 The % of people on the CHD register whose total cholesterol or LDL was recorded in the last 12 months and where the last recorded results was $\leq 2\text{mmol/L}$ for LDL or $< 4\text{mmol/L}$ for cholesterol.

Health services recorded a steady improvement in the CHD measures over the course of the combined waves. Participants recorded an improvement of 10.52% for the Blood Pressure measure and 8.69% for the Cholesterol or LDL measure.
